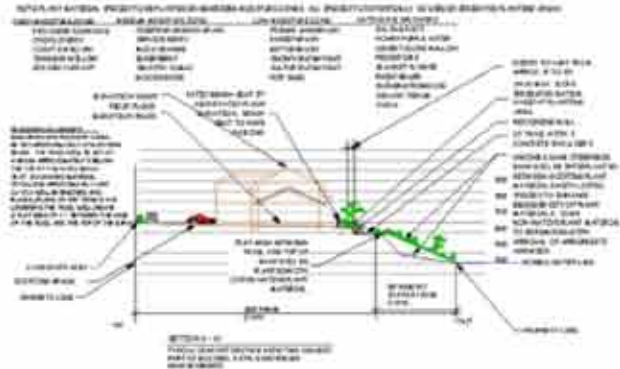


## Environmental Planning, Permitting, & Design

### Tri Cities, WA - Riverwalk

This development, to be located on the Columbia River in the Tri Cities, in southeastern Washington State, is a mixed-use project which will ultimately include several hundred town homes, condominiums, apartments, and commercial and retail business spaces. Some of the key aspects of the project are moving an existing pathway within buffer areas of the Columbia River to facilitate a 200 foot shoreline regulatory area, providing design concepts for trail relocation to provide separation of residential use from public trail use in a tight space, and facilitating wildlife and wetland enhancements.

#### Sun Cove Columbia River Dredging Project

We provided coordination, permitting activities, mitigation negotiation, and oversight for this project which consisted of dredging out two coves, rebuilding a boat launch and the installation of new dock structures.
