



City of Pateros, WA - Urban Redevelopment Plan

The goal of this project was to outline the concepts and steps that would make the city of Pateros an attractive location to live and visit during all seasons of the year. This small central Washington community has an abundance of opportunity to become a major recreation center, so the project focused on 13 items that the city identified as important to their economic growth.

City of Wenatchee, WA - Wenatchee Avenue Master Plan

This study, directed by a citizens' committee, looked at opportunities to use landscaping, street trees, street furniture, and other means to create a master plan for the development of Wenatchee Avenue. The study also established an identity for the north and south entrances to the City, and examined traffic calming and pedestrian issues.

City of Quincy, WA - Economic Redevelopment Study

This project, done in partnership with RMErickson, involved completing an economic study of the City of Quincy, developing a survey for citizen response, designing a new streetscape for the downtown business district, and providing design guidelines for the highway and street corridors for safe vehicular movement and pedestrianization of the City.

City of Quincy, WA - Central Avenue Project

Working as part of the design team, ecoPlan & Design provided sidewalk layout, passive traffic control, safe pedestrian crossing design for the intersections, and irrigation and landscape design for the redevelopment of Quincy's Central Avenue.
